ID	19-03 GIFA Questions and Answers
1	<p>Can SBIRT or recovery support services be included in a proposal? No. Funds from this grant shall not be used for screening and brief intervention or recovery support services.</p>
2	<p>Are we able to use this funding for weekend initiatives and events such as trips to Kennywood Park for a weekend evening at Holiday Lights, a Saturday night trip to a Laser Tag venue, a Saturday evening trip to go snow tubing, etc.? Yes.</p>
3	<p>As the health system of a university, we would partner with our university to engage, educate and treat students. Is this allowable? The eligible applicants for GIFA 19-03 are non-profit, accredited colleges, universities, community colleges, and other Post-Secondary Institutions of Higher Education and collegiate collaboratives with Pennsylvania.</p>
4	<p>What is the source of the funds for this grant? The source of the funds is from the State Opioid Response (SOR) Grant.</p>
5	<p>Is there a percentage limit on in-direct costs? The information regarding the in-direct costs is listed in Section 6 of the GIFA.</p>
6	<p>Where can I find the budget template, appendix C-1 that is required for the application? The budget template, appendix C-1 is located on the DDAP website under Funding Opportunities. The budget template listed under GIFA 19-03 must be used.</p>
7	<p>We were interested in knowing if this grant will be offered annually? There is potential for this grant to be offered next federal fiscal year depending on funding.</p>
8	<p>Should we submit a two-year budget? No. All applicants only need to provide a budget which addresses all expenses for a one-year time frame.</p>
